
OBTAINING MIROMAA







OBTAINING MIROMAA

Miromaa can be obtained by requesting a licence from us.

There are two ways you can do this, either by requesting **sponsorship** of a licence or by **purchasing** a licence.



SPONSORSHIP

If you are an Indigenous, Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person working directly on maintaining a traditional language you may be able to receive Miromaa at no cost.

If you are Language Centre or similar organisation working directly with the maintenance of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander languages you may be able to receive Miromaa at no cost.

If you are a Linguist, Researcher or other Academic working directly with Indigenous, Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people in the maintenance of their traditional language you may be able to receive Miromaa at no cost.



PURCHASE

If you are a School, TAFE, College, University, Government Department or other as determined by us you can purchase a licence for:

1 to 4 licenses - \$550 each license (Full price – no discount) 5 to 10 licenses - \$360 each license (saving of approx. 33%) 11 or more licenses - \$275 each license (saving of approx. 50%) All pricing includes GST


